Being in a play is a commitment -To Yourself, Your Fellow Students, The School System, and Your Drama Coaches.
Once the commitment is made students are expected to honor it.

Students are expected to attend rehearsals unless otherwise engaged in a school program or work. The RBBSC shared time policies will be followed. Students are asked to attempt to adjust work schedules so they may attend as many rehearsals as possible. Students must be available for performances and the final dress rehearsal. (Most likely the day before the first show) and should make every effort to attend all rehearsals the two weeks before the show. The Directors will make every effort to work around as many students' extracurricular activities as possible.

Students are expected to begin working on their lines as soon as they receive their scripts and have their lines memorized by the announced off book dates. **Don't expect to memorize your lines and songs during rehearsals**.

## If you are unable to attend a rehearsal let the directors know as far in advance a possible.

Students are to inform the directors immediately if there is a conflict. Students must inform the directors no later than two weeks in advance, unless such notification is impossible, in which case notification should be made as soon as possible. This means when you find out about the conflict, not the day of rehearsal, not two days later. Failure to notify the directors two weeks in advance more than three times may endanger your participation in the play cast or crew. Exceptions will be handled on individual basis.

Forgetfulness, or adding a commitment after publication of the schedule will not be considered an excuse. Lying about illness or tests or other commitments will be grounds for immediately losing participation in the play's cast or crew. Theft of other students', or staff's, or school property, even as a prank, will be grounds for immediately losing participation in the play's crew or cast and will be reported to the school administration.

Students are expected to keep their grades up. If there is an issue or a potential issue in this area please let the directors know as soon as possible. Students – if you are available and interested in tutoring other students in any subject area please let the directors know.

Edgewood Theatre Arts will attempt to provide as much costuming and make-up as possible. However, students or their parents may be asked to provide some costume pieces. Hair color and styles should look natural. Facial hair on men may be acceptable for some characters.

Pictures of Students will be taken for use in related social media and publicity. If there is a problem with this please let the directors know.
